

IRIS Center Logic Model

Project goals: Develop, revise, and maintain innovative, accessible, digital open educational resources (OERs) that translate research to practice about EBPs; disseminate OERs for use in personnel development and personalized learning; and increase the capacity of pre-service and professional development providers to build educators' knowledge and skills to use EBPs with cultural and linguistic competence to improve results for all students, particularly struggling learners, students with disabilities, and those from underserved populations.
