Checklist for Providing Professional Development To
Ensure Effective Intervention
Goals and objectives are derived from an in-depth needs assessment.
Modeling, demonstration, and practice are included in initial and ongoing training opportunities.
Provide ongoing support (e.g., mentoring, coaching, booster sessions).
Instructional staff is provided with ready access to a trained individual who can help to implement the practice or program.
Training and follow-up on the use of all practice or program materials is provided.
A classroom observation tool is used to ensure that professional development is appropriately transferred into classroom practice.
An intervention observation tool is used to determine the extent to which teachers are appropriately implementing the intervention programs.
Implementation coordinator(s) use data to evaluate the effectiveness of professional development in the implementation of the practice or program.
Follow-up and on-site support designed to improve the fidelity of implementation are based on these data.
