<u> Tier 1</u>

Core reading curriculum by grade

K-New Horizons, 1st-Pioneers, 2nd-Castles, 3rd-Beacon, 4th-Athena

Length of core reading instruction across all grades

90 minutes

Types of instructional practices

Small groups, learning centers, peer tutoring

Progress-monitoring procedures

- Monitor entire class
- Probes administered by the teacher who provides reading instruction
- Duration of progress monitoring: 6 weeks following each universal screening
- Frequency of the progress monitoring: once per week
- Progress monitoring measure: Vanderbilt probes appropriate for each grade level
- Criteria established by each probe will be used to determine which students are in need of Tier 2 intervention

Data-based decision making procedures

- Evaluate each student's progress monitoring data at the end of the monitoring period.
- If a student's slope is equal to or greater than the specified rate of growth, the student is responding adequately to instruction. The student should continue receiving Tier 1 instruction only.
- If a student's slope is less than the specified rate of growth, more intensive instruction, like that provided in Tier 2, is warranted. The teacher will present the data at the grade-level team meeting, and the team will make a final decision regarding whether the student should receive Tier 2 intervention.)
