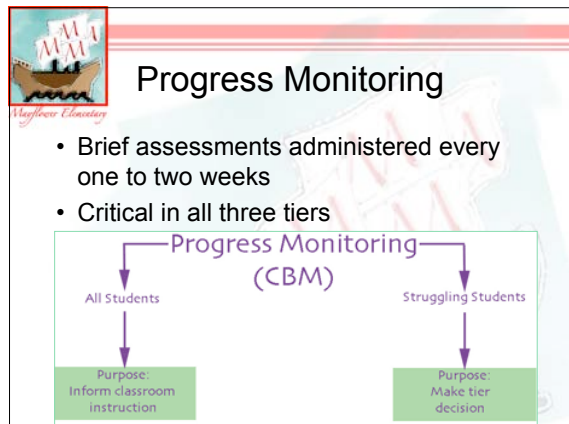

- Overview of RTI
- RTI incorporates multilevel interventions, high-quality instruction, frequent progress monitoring, and data-based decision making.
  - RTI allows for early intervening before students fall too far behind their peers or before they experience years of failure.
  - RTI facilitates the identification of students who have learning disabilities.

- RTI Components
- Universal screening
  - Tier 1 - classroom instruction
  - Tier 2 - targeted intervention
  - Tier 3 - intense, individualized interventions





## Benefits of RTI

- Early intervening services for struggling students
- Identifying students with learning disabilities in the early grades (before they have to wait to fail)
- Potentially reducing the overrepresentation of culturally and linguistically diverse students in special education



## Benefits of RTI (cont.)

- Potentially reducing behavior problems
- Encouraging greater staff, parent, and student involvement in the educational process
- Collecting assessment data directly related to instruction
- Aligning with NCLB targets and district initiatives



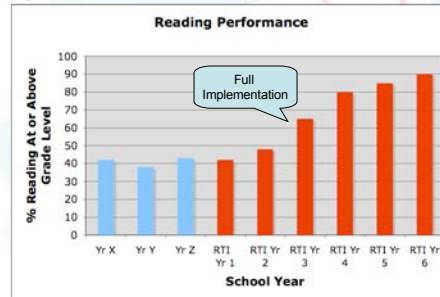
## Rosa Parks Results

- At the end of two years, the percent of first-grade students ( $n=110$ ) reading at grade level increased from 42% ( $n=38$ ) to 71% ( $n=65$ ).
- The second-grade teachers reported that incoming students were much more advanced in their reading skills than students had been in previous years.
- The principal reported greater parent participation in the education of their children.



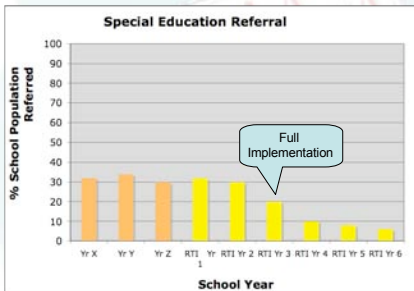
## Desired Student Performance
